Accomplishments since the last board meeting

Road and Ground work

- Seth Trinkle continues to monitor and remove leaf and branch buildup at all of our culverts and do our mowing. We are pleased with his service.
- New gravel was added to the community parking lot by the boat dock.
- The “Little Free Library” was moved from Pfeiffers to a new post at the community parking lot by the boat dock (thanks Diane and Hud).
- The “No ATV Parking on Grass (with exception of mobility impaired)” sign has been very effective.
- A new culvert was installed halfway down Ella St (just past Bantz’s driveway) to reduce the amount of water that flows along the high side of Ella St. We are pleased with this installation.

Future Projects

- We are waiting on a quote to put in a small handicap parking spot near the boat dock ramp.
- This fall we will again have leaves removed along Salt Creek roadway’s.
- New private road signs and posts have been purchased and will be installed later this fall or early in the spring.
- We are assessing whether we need fall grading or if it can be put off to spring.
